Stained Glass Window Dedication Delayed

June 28 was to be the day we were to dedicate the stained-glass windows as part of our celebration of Immanuel's 150th anniversary. The project includes placing historic windows that were in the 1890 building in the sides of the sanctuary, together with new windows designed to expand their message. The new, insulated protective glass has been installed. Abandoned heating units have been removed and replaced with stone. Some historic windows have been moved, but the lighting is not yet finished. Solar screens are also to be placed in the Atrium and narthex.

The Butler Vargo studios in Indianapolis had to stop work for a while due to the COVID-19 shut-downs there. The Committee determined to postpone the dedication until the whole project can be completed. Former Pastor Ronald Mueller was also to be our anniversary preacher on June 28, but the current issues with COVID-19 have cancelled his visit at this time.

490th Anniversary

Are you confident enough about your convictions that you would be willing to say them in front of everyone? This Thursday is a good day to think about that. June 25, 1530 is the day Lutheran reformers gave public witness to what they were teaching before the emperor and the Roman Catholic church. Dr. Martin Luther and other teachers had protested that certain important teachings of the church were not based on the Bible. Some in the church labeled them heretics that should be outlawed. But at Augsburg, Germany, they publicly showed that what they were teaching was in fact what the Bible teaches and what the early Christians believed. Their statement of faith is called to this day the Augsburg Confession, and it simply and clearly outlines how Lutherans teach the Christian faith.
