While there will not be an Easter breakfast, there will be special activities for children. See the insert for more information.

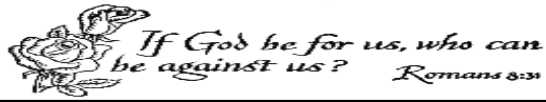
## Communion Together
