Lessons and Activities

Creative/Sensory	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Watch and track if babies use both hands to interact with food or toys• Track eye movement-move toy up and down and watch babies keep eye contact with movement
Language/Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read Bible Story to Babies• Saying phrases-Please, Thank you, Yes, No, More, etc.• Sign Language Practice (above words)-Show babies the motions to words at appropriate times. Make games out of it with toys• Talk to babies by name and watch reactions to being called by name
Math/Counting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use number phrases and finger motions (ex: you drank 2 ounces! We have 5 friends here, etc.)• Use positional words-up, down, under, over, in, out (example: put toys in a tub, let them dump out• Use color words-point out colors in room
Science/Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good Health-Helping and guiding the regulation of emotions• Use musical toys to watch and track babies reactions to sounds
Music/Movement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Capture the toy-babies that are mobile-have them crawl to toy or place toy on shelf for them to pull up and grab• Practice using utensils at lunch time• Clap to rhythm of songs• "Simon Says"-do an action and have kids imitate you
